
## **Following God's Instruction**

As Christmas has ended and the New Year has sprung, are you wondering, "What are God's plans for you?" What is God speaking to you about in 2010? I encourage you to find the answers in prayer with God.

#### Matthew 7:6-8 (New International Version)

<sup>6</sup>"Do not give dogs what is sacred; do not throw your pearls to pigs. If you do, they may trample them under their feet, and then turn and tear you to pieces. <sup>7</sup>"Ask and it will be given to you; seek and you will find; knock and the door will be opened to you. <sup>8</sup>For everyone who asks receives; he who seeks, finds; and to him who knocks, the door will be opened.

It is imperative that we start the year off right. There is no more time for part-time praying, fulltime wishing, and no godly counsel before making major decisions regarding your life. The time is here for full-time praying, fulltime fasting and full-time believing on the Lord's manifestation. As I have said many times before, If you want something you've never had, you have to do something you've never done. When was the last time you determined you were going to go into your prayer closet and not come out until you heard from the Lord?



Through David, we learn a very valuable lesson. In the Kingdom of God, there is only one way to approach God: God's way. God's way is prayer. The word says in Phil 4:6 *"Do not fret or have* any anxiety about anything, but in every circumstance and in everything, by prayer and supplication <sup>(</sup>definite requests), with thanksgiving, continue to make your requests known to God." Our motives may be pure and we may have the best of intentions, but if we aren't seeking God's counsel in ALL the steps of our lives, we might as well be playing a game of solitaire for all the good it will do. In fact, as you will see shortly, one man paid the supreme price for his ignorance of God's will; his life was forfeited. Doing the

right thing in the wrong way is no way to serve God. David, the warrior-king, wanted Jerusalem to be, not only the military and political capital of the nation of Israel, but the religious center as well. In order for that to happen, the centerpiece of Judaism, the Ark of the Covenant, needed to be brought to Jerusalem. The Ark, as you will recall, was the visible symbol of the presence of the invisible God, and a type of the Jesus Christ, God manifest in the flesh. God. The ark of God was an extremely holy object, representing His presence (see *Exodus 25:21-22*). It had to be handled with the utmost regard to strict regulation in the Law of Moses, which mandated that the care of the most holy things was entrusted to the Levitical sons of Kohath (Numbers 3:29-31). Yet even these caretakers were not to touch the holy articles or so much as look casually upon them "lest they die" (Num. 4:15,20). The Kohathites were instructed to carry the ark on their shoulders by poles passing through rings on the ark's corners to keep them from touching it (4:1-16; Exodus 25:14-15).

## **Following God's Instruction**

It was not to be transported by cart or any other vehicle (*Numbers 7:6-9*). David, however, was using the same transport method the Philistines had used (*1 Samuel 6:7-8*).

Yet God says, "Therefore you shall be careful to do as the LORD your God has commanded you; you shall not turn aside to the right hand or to the left" (Deuteronomy 5:32). And: "You shall not add to the word which I command you, nor take from it, that you may keep the commandments of the LORD your God which I command you" (Deut. 4:2). Also: "Whatever I command you, be careful to observe it; you shall not add to it nor take away from it" (Deut. 12:32).

We are never to reason against, or attempt to change, God's commands. A king was not to be ignorant of God's instruction: "Also it shall be, when he sits on the throne of his kingdom, that he shall write for himself a copy of this law in a book, from the one before the priests, the Levites. And it shall be with him, and he shall read it all the days of his life, that he may learn to fear the LORD his God and be careful to observe all the words of this law and these statutes, that his heart may not be lifted above his brethren, that he may not turn aside from the commandment to the right hand or to the left, and that he may prolong his days in his kingdom, he and his children in the midst of Israel" (17:18-20). Thus, God requires much of a leader He chooses. 1 Chronicles 13

<sup>2</sup>And David said to all the assembly of Israel, If it seems good to you and if it is of the Lord our God, let us send abroad everywhere to our brethren who are left in all the land of Israel, and with them to the priests and Levites in their cities that have suburbs and pasturelands, that they may gather together with us.

with us. And let us bring again the ark of our God to us, for we did not seek it during the days of Saul.

<sup>4</sup>And all the assembly agreed to do so, for the thing seemed right in the eyes of all the people.

You see here, David sought the counsel of all the people around him, but did not seek the Lord's counsel. Sometimes it's easy for us to seek the opinions of friends and family, but it's vital to seek God's guidance on even the small steps of our lives. Also, when God gives us instructions, it's important to follow what he says step by step.

Isaiah 28:10 - For precept must be upon precept, precept upon precept; line upon line, line upon line; here a little, and there a little.

If David wanted to see the true manifestation of God for his people, he had to follow God's instructions EXACTLY!

Isaiah 28:10 tells us how to follow God's instructions. We can't get it all in one Sunday/Wednesday service. We also can't get it all in one prayer session, so we must constantly and consistently seek the Lord in our daily walk. I remember watching an episode of the Oprah Winfrey Show and Billy Graham was her special guest. Oprah asked Dr. Graham if there was one thing that he could do over again after having been in the ministry for all these years and winning so many souls to Christ, what would that one thing be? Dr. Graham's response was, "I'd spend more time praying." I was blown away. Here was Billy Graham, one of the greatest evangelists the world has ever known, someone who has won numbers into the millions to Christ saying that he wishes that he had spent more time in prayer.

The Bible is our book of instructions for all parts of our life. If we would follow the instructions God gives us in His Book, we will be successful in all our endeavors. This includes marriage, parenting, the single life, business, old age, finances, worship, and all other areas of our life. If we will follow the instructions WITH UNDER-STANDING of God's purpose for life on earth, we will avoid many mistakes; other people make, and live a life that is worth living. It is sad how many Christians come to the end of their life and have not accomplished much that is worthwhile and lasting.

#### Romans 12:1,2

Therefore I urge you, brothers, by the mercies of God, to present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable to God, which is your reasonable service. Don't be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, so that you may prove what is the good and acceptable and perfect will of God.

Hallelujah! Praise the Lord! We made it. And we did it VICTORIOUSLY!

We pray as you continue your holiday season; you are blessed and overwhelmed by the goodness of God each and every day. Again, because of our persistent faith and prayers, and keeping the word of God as the final authority in our lives, the God of the Breakthrough has been able to break forth at our hand. Praise God, He is faithful to the faithful and has given us the victory, but don't get relaxed, complacent or begin to chill out just yet for we still have a ways to go. It is still **CRUNCH TIME!** 

We are still talking about 'Persevering to the End'. We have to persevere in keeping good relationships; persevere in our prayer life (the devil does not want you to pray, so you have to press your way through); persevere in studying the word of God; persevere in implementing the word we study. Our entire life as Christians is all about ensuring that we stay in the perfect will of God for our lives and do what God has called us to do. This means we must become a people who will purpose in our heart to go the distance. We cannot quit, cave in, give up, or become distracted by the cares of this world. As we begin 2010, let's cling to what Paul said in Hebrews 12:1-2a "Therefore then, since we are surrounded by so great a cloud of witnesses [who have borne testimony to the Truth], let us strip off and throw aside every encumbrance (unnecessary weight) and that sin which so readily (deftly and cleverly) clings to and entangles us, and let us run with patient endurance and steady and active persistence the appointed course of the race that is set before us. Looking away [from all that will distract] to Jesus, Who is the Leader and the Source of our faith [giving the first incentive for our belief] and is also it's Finisher [bringing it to maturity and perfection]. Just because the going gets tough,

know that anything worth having is not going to be easy. It will always be a press.

Now that I have laid the foundation for persevering to the end, let's continue with our character in the word of God who did just that. Nehemiah, the cupbearer to King Artaxerxes had #1) a great **concern** about the deplorable condition of Jerusalem. Secondly, Nehemiah steps up to the plate and rose to the **challenge**. And third, you must know that anytime God assigns you a task to do, there will be **conflict** with the enemy.

Today, our message begins with Nehemiah's **confirmation.** "Then answered I them, and said unto them, the God of heaven, he will prosper us; therefore, we his servants will arise and build: but ye have no portion, nor right, nor memorial, in Jerusalem." Nehemiah 2:20.

This scripture, by far, is one of my favorite verses in the Book of Nehemiah. You see there were various kinds of gods during this time, but God's ambassador, Nehemiah, made it very clear to the enemy that it would not be Baal, Sun Moon, Buddha, or any other idol god who would bless their good work. He made it plain to the enemy that the God of heaven would prosper them. Let me share this with you. Nehemiah knew, without any doubt, that he and the people could fully depend on the Lord, God of heaven and earth. In spite of the threats by the opposition, the reason he could take such a firm stand is because he knew something about the God he served and he knew he was doing what he had been commissioned to do.

Know that the enemy has no part, nor right, nor memorial in what God has called you to do. Co-laborer, in your Christian walk, I want you to know and fully understand that obedience to God places you in the perfect position (not just a good position or an acceptable position) to receive the abundance, blessings, and protection of God. And those blessings are not to be shared in whole or in part with the enemy. This is



what Nehemiah meant when he said to the opposition, '...you have no portion, nor right, nor memorial in Jerusalem" and I might add, this project.

With this established, Nehemiah begins the **commitment**. He said in Nehemiah 4:6, "So built we the wall; and all the wall was joined together unto the half thereof: for the people had a mind to work." Church, this project required a people who were committed, with great discipline, tenacity, persistence, perseverance, a mustard seed faith, and above all else, a mind and body to go to work!

The enemy never stopped harassing Nehemiah and his help. The enemy is never going to stop harassing you. But you have to remain committed to the work, task, or assignment that God has called you to do. No matter how great a force the enemy may gather against you, keep your eyes on the Lord! I believe this simple message on persevering will get you started in the right direction in 2010. Be persistent in the things of God. There is no room for vascillating, hesitating, or changing your mind when it comes to the things of God. Be about the Father's business so that you can finish strong!

Again, I admonish you to walk daily in the love of God and hold on to the promises of God, God is faithful. Whatever He has promised you, He is well able to perform. And again, I say, 'GOD PAYS BIG'. Until the next time, continue to let Abba Father find faithfulness and perseverance in you.






