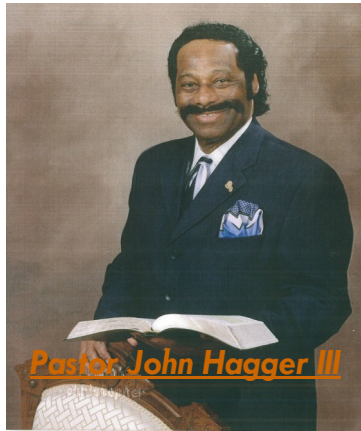

### **Victory to Victory, The time of salvation is now!**

Jesus came in the fullness of time. Let us rejoice at this season that the Royal Son, King Messiah, came and established his kingdom. Let us be encouraged that millions around the world are coming to faith, embracing his rule, and being transformed from the dominion of darkness and death to the dominion of life and light.

*But when the fullness of the time was come, God sent forth his Son, made of a woman, made under the law, to redeem them that were under the law, that we might receive the adoption of sons. (Galatians 4:4-5)*

The true Light of the World came and dwelt with his people. He came to die for our sins and to conquer death so that we can receive the adoption as sons. He came that all the peoples of the earth might experience freedom from spiritual oppression and liberation from the dominion of sin and death. *2 Corinthians 5:19-21 (Amplified Bible)*

*<sup>19</sup>It was God [personally present] in Christ, reconciling and restoring the world to favor with Himself, not counting up and holding against [men] their trespasses [but cancelling them], and committing to us the message of reconciliation (of the restoration to favor).*

*<sup>20</sup>So we are Christ's ambassadors, God making His appeal as it were through us. We [as Christ's personal representatives] beg you for His sake to lay hold of the divine favor [now offered you] and be reconciled to God.*

*<sup>21</sup>For our sake He made Christ [virtually] to be sin Who knew no sin, so that in and through Him we might become [<sup>21</sup>endued with, viewed as being in, and examples of] the righteousness of God [what we ought to be, approved and acceptable and in right relationship with*

*Him, by His goodness].*

God's purpose is to redeem fellowship back unto himself. This is why Jesus blood was shed. Why did God have to create a body for himself, because without a body, on earth, he would be illegal. God can do anything, but he is also bound by his own laws. God can remember your sins no more once you have been born again!

Only the devil has record of your wrongs! He tries to use your past to be an accuser of the brethren, but you have the victory!

God could have redeemed anybody, but he chose you! Jesus became sin for you. He became everything that you are going through or have went through. The anointing is the unction to function. It gives you a flow in what you are doing. The anointing is what you need to preach. It is through the Gospel that people are saved. Paul said, “I am not ashamed of the Gospel of Jesus Christ for it is the POWER of God!”

The spirit can only minister to those who are desperate for it. We must operate in the power because there are multitudes of people who need healing ministered to them. This can be mental or physical.

You can pretty much bet that if you ask God to open a door for you to minister in this area, a door will be opened. Jesus has already paved the way. You just have to go out and do it!

*Mark 16:15-20 (King James Version)*

*<sup>15</sup>And he said unto them, Go ye into all the world, and preach the gospel to every creature.*

*<sup>16</sup>He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved; but he that believeth not shall be damned.*

*<sup>17</sup>And these signs shall follow them that believe; In my name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues;*

*<sup>18</sup>They shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover.*

*<sup>19</sup>So then after the Lord had spoken unto them, he was received up into heaven, and sat on the right hand of God.*

*<sup>20</sup>And they went forth, and preached every where, the Lord working with them, and confirming the word with signs following. Amen.*

When I say 'we made it', I mean that we got through 2009. And we did it victoriously!

We pray that you are continually blessed and overwhelmed by the goodness of God each and every day. Again, because of our persistent faith and prayers, and keeping the word of God as the final authority in our lives, the God of the Breakthrough has been able to break forth at our hand. Praise God, He is faithful to the faithful and has given us the victory, but don't get relaxed, complacent or begin to chill out just yet for we still have a ways to go. It is still **CRUNCH TIME!**

We are still talking about '**Persevering to the End**'. We can never allow the enemy to come in with his quitting attitude, dramatic sideshows, or subtle distractions. This means that we have to ensure we stay in the perfect will of God for our lives and do what God has called us to do. It also means we must become a people who will purpose in our heart to go the distance. We cannot quit, cave in, give up, or become distracted by the cares of this world. As we begin the third month of 2010, let's cling to what Paul said in Hebrews 12:1-2a "Therefore then, since we are surrounded by so great a cloud of witnesses [who have borne testimony to the Truth], let us strip off and throw aside every encumbrance (unnecessary weight) and that sin which so readily (deftly and cleverly) clings to and entangles us, and let us run with patient endurance and steady and active persistence the appointed course of the race that is set before us. Looking away [from all that will distract] to Jesus, Who is the Leader and the Source of our faith [giving the first incentive for our belief] and is also its Finisher [bringing it to maturity and perfection]. Just because the going gets tough, know that anything worth having is not going to be easy. It will always be a press. I have used the above scripture throughout this series of lessons be-

cause it is loaded with telling us that we must stay put, stay focused and stay in the race.

Now that I have laid the foundation for persevering to the end, let's continue with our character in the word of God who did just that. Nehemiah, the cup-bearer to King Artaxerxes had #1) a great **concern** about the deplorable condition of Jerusalem. Secondly, Nehemiah stepped up to the plate and rose to the **challenge**. The third thing Nehemiah did was dealt with the **conflict** with the enemy head-on. The fourth thing he did was faced the **opposition**.

You see, believers, once the Lord gives you an assignment, it is then up to you to follow through on that assignment until it is finished. It is at this time the devil seizes this opportunity to hinder the work or to cause it to cease permanently. The one thing I have found out is that I have to be more persistent than the devil. In other words, you have to be more determined to fulfill the assignment than he is to stop you from fulfilling the assignment.

Today, we want to talk about Nehemiah's **concentration**. "Nevertheless, we made our prayer unto our God, and set a watch against them day and night because of them." Nehemiah 4:9.

My dear friends, I love how Nehemiah turned his concentration toward God. The Bible says the people of God said, "Nevertheless." To me this signified no matter what evil plot the enemy had planned; no matter how the enemy outnumbered the people of God; no matter how many threats were hurled their way, the people of God kept a 'no quit' attitude. You know, it kind of reminds me of us. We come week after week gathering to pray the vision of the house. It does not matter to the faithful who shows or don't show; it does not matter to the faithful who prays or don't pray, we keep our concentration on the Lord, the word

of God and His promises to us. And in every situation God has assigned you, that is what you must do.

Now the **conclusion** of the matter. "Then he said unto them, Go your way, eat the fat, and drink the sweet, and send portions unto them for whom



nothing is prepared: for **this day is** holy unto our Lord: Neither be ye grieved; for the joy of the Lord is your strength." Nehemiah 8:10 Church, as you go about your assignment for the Lord, there are three things I want you to keep in mind.

First, the Lord honors the request of His children. Philippians 4:6 tells us, "Be careful for nothing; but in everything by prayer and supplication, let your request be made known unto the Lord." Nehemiah did this day and night, night and day and God heard and answered him.

Secondly, know that "God is not the author of confusion, but of peace, .." II Cor. 14:33. Remember, whenever you are doing a good work for the Lord, the devil wants to get, not on the fringe and watch, but right in the middle of the good work that is taking place. His objective is outlined in John 10:10, "... the thief comes to steal, kill and destroy." We, as believers, are not deceived by Satan's devices.

And thirdly, as you go about your God-given assignment, know that the "The joy of the Lord is your strength and stronghold" Nehemiah 8:10.

Again, I admonish you to walk daily in the love of God and hold on to the promises of God, God is faithful. Whatever He has promised you, He is well able to perform. And again, I say, 'GOD PAYS BIG'. Until the next time, continue to let Abba Father find faithfulness and perseverance in you.

# FoodBank Training

Imitation is said to be the best form of flattery. I am proud to say Victory to Victory Outreach Center has been a recipient of such flattery this month. Pastor Alan Haskins and his wife, First Lady Katrina Haskins of Awake to Righteousness Church came this month specifically for training in food distribution. "I want to do this thing right, so I knew who to come to for help and assistance in setting things up correctly", said Pastor Haskins.



Since partnering with the Southeast Texas Food Bank, Victory To Victory Outreach Center receives approximately 25 referrals each month. Doris, a staff member at the Southeast Texas Food Bank says, "We recommend Victory to Victory Outreach Center because it is the most consistent food pantry in our Beaumont Network."

The outreach staff showed the Haskins the process we use on a daily basis. We went through the entire process from client intake to food distribution. The Haskins were very intuitive and had many questions. Some questions asked were the following: are there portions of your geographic area that we do not serve? Are there any times of the day in which no other existing food pantry is open? Is the amount of food we provide to families requesting [help](#) sufficient? How many times will they serve the same family in a month, quarter or year? Have we ever run out of food? These and many other pressing issues were resolved with ease by Operations Manager, Naomi Dodd.

Other questions raised and resolved were developing organizational policies for tracking and distribution. We showed them how we determined to create our package, which is setup to feed a family of four for two weeks (some supplemental items may have to be purchased).

They were impressed! Pastor Alan Haskins concluded "You all seem to have it all figured out". Pastor Haskins and First Lady Haskins were greatly impressed not only by the efficiency of staff at the outreach, but the level of compassion and fellowship that goes into serving each customer. "Victory to Victory Outreach staff not only love on the customers physically by helping them with their immediate food needs, we have captured the 'vision of the house' and want to love on each person with dignity and respect no matter how great or small the need. Many people come to the Outreach Center, not just for a bag of groceries, but for a loving hand and a prayer. Sometimes they come just needing someone to tell them no matter what you are going through, God will help you make it through to the other side.

At the Victory to Victory Outreach Center it is safe to say we are fighting hunger, empowering people while at the same time, allowing them to keep their dignity and respect.

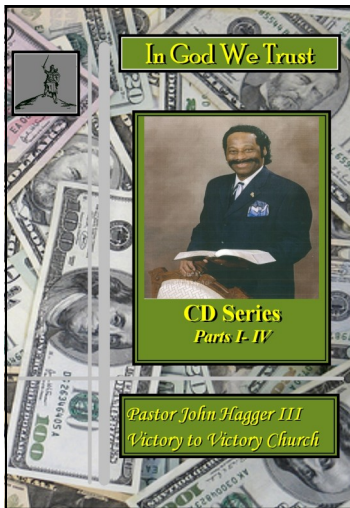

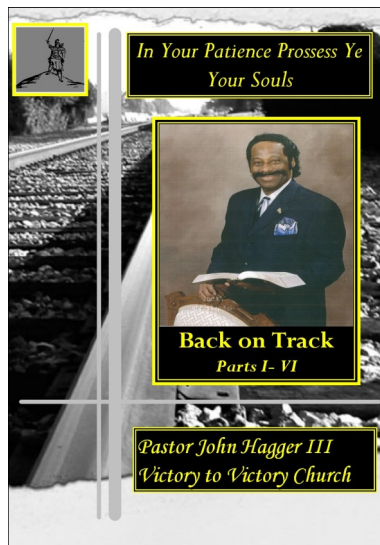

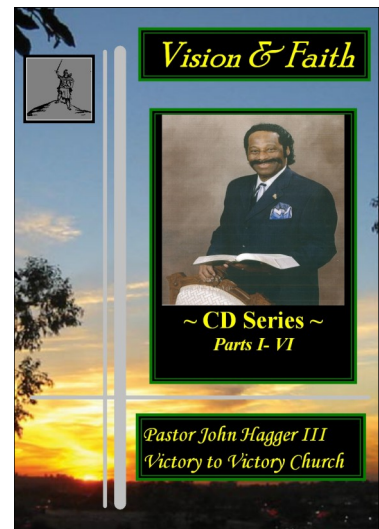
